Children's Activity: Easter Sunday

Bible Reading: Luke 24:1-6 [CEV]

Very early on Sunday morning the women went to the tomb, carrying the spices that they had prepared. ² When they found the stone rolled away from the entrance, ³ they went in. But they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus, ⁴ and they did not know what to think. Suddenly two men in shining white clothes stood beside them. ⁵ The women were afraid and bowed to the ground. But the men said, "Why are you looking in the place of the dead for someone who is alive? ⁶ Jesus isn't here! He has been raised from death.

Introduction Activity:

Discussion Questions:

1. What were some of the amazing miracles Jesus did during His time on earth? [turning water into wine, calming storms, healing the sick and raising people back to life.]
2. Why did he help so many boys, girls, men and women? [He loved them, He wanted them to know God, He wanted them to have peace and joy.]
3. Why is it important that we know Jesus came to life again? [He has power over sin and death. He is the Messiah that God had promised long ago, the Son of God!]
4. What can you do to celebrate Jesus today? [Allow for children's creative party ideas and share these with us by emailing mim.hosking@mounties.org.au]

Activity Options:

1. Create the second half of your Good Friday/Easter Sunday craft in 3D or on paper. Like two sides of a coin.
