Luke 12 – 13:21

1. Warns about Hypocrisy (Luke 12:1-12)

- Knowing the truth and not acting on it
- “Evangelism is one beggar telling another beggar where to find bread?”
- Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit is not unforgivable because it is “too big” for God to forgive, but if you reject the work of the Holy Spirit you end up rejecting Jesus Himself.

2. Warning about our true treasure (Luke 12:13-34) Parable of the rich fool

- Be rich towards God
- “**Therefore** I tell you...” (Luke 12:22) - When you see a therefore, you must always ask what it is there for?
- “But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.”

3. Warning about being prepared (Luke 12:35-48) Parable of the men waiting for their master to return, the thief coming in the night, parable of the wise manager

4. Warning about Division (Luke 12:49-53)

5. Warning about the need of repentance (Luke 13:1-9) – Parable of the fig tree

- Luke 3:8-9 – *Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. And do not begin to say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham as our father.’ For I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham. The axe is ready at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.*
