Children's Activity: Sunday 24 May 2020

Bible Reading: Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Discussion Questions:

DISCUSSION: Hot Tip - Parents be prepared to share a story or two about the storms of life and how you know God can be trusted.

1. Think about a time you had a problem, big or small. How did God help you get through or stay strong in that situation?
2. Retell the story from Mark 4:35-41 when the disciples were in the boat during the storm; where was Jesus? What did He do and say? Take note of Jesus' last words "Where is your faith?" Or "When will you trust me?" What did the disciples learn that night?
3. What is one thing you can remind yourself next time you need to trust Jesus in a difficult situation?

Prayer:

Thank Jesus for always being with you, for caring about you and helping your family through the hard times of life. Ask that you will be reminded to trust Jesus and ask for His help whenever you face the storms of life.

ACTIVITY:

Create a jar or diary of thankfulness, decorate it and fill with written stories and drawings of the times God has helped your family. You can keep adding to the collection in the years to come and read the stories when you need a reminder of what God has done.
