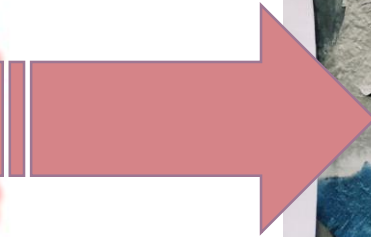
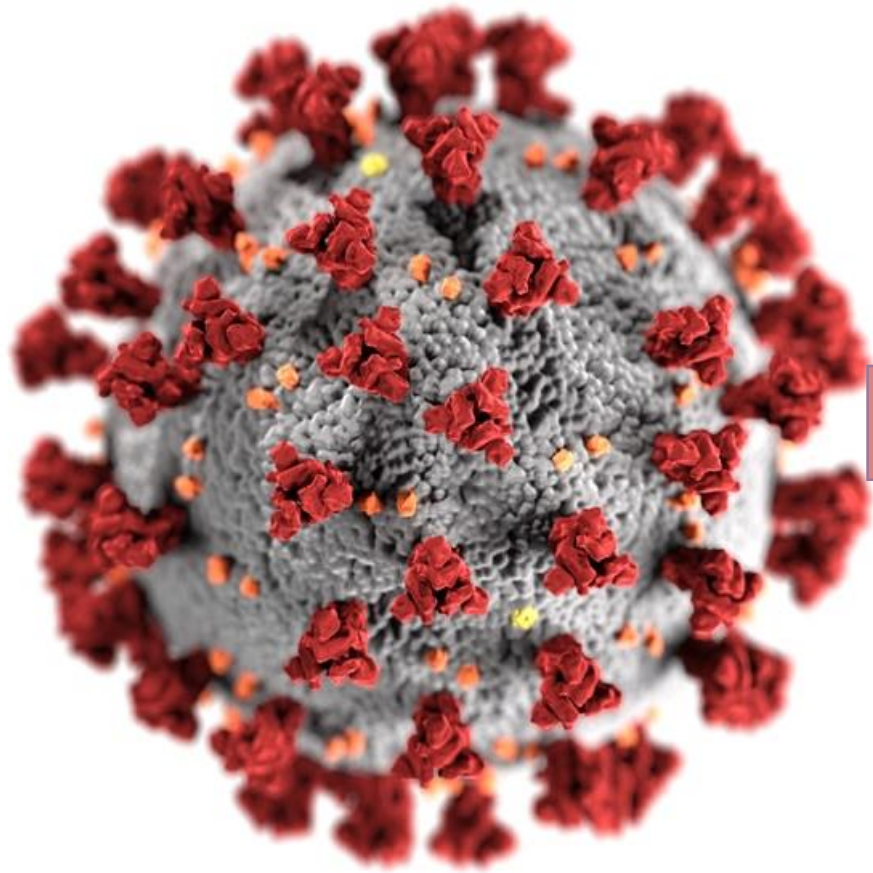


Reorientation
