"How I long for the months gone by ..." (29:2)

v.1-6 Job's relationship to God

v.7-11 Job's standing in society

v.12-17 Job's acts of mercy

v.18-20 Job's future

v.21-25 Job's position of honour



This is now ... (Job 30)

"But now they mock me ..." (30:1)

- v.1-8 unworthy people
- v.9-11 young men mock me, I am left defenceless
- v.12-15 the attack comes
- v.16-19 my life is failing
- v.20-23 I cry out to you God
- v.24-31 surely that is not right



Job's defence (Job 31)

Style of defence

Legal argument

"May God do to me, if I do

Oath of innocence

- (or do not do) so and so"
- 4x names the curse if guilty (v.8, v.10, v.22, v.40)

"His reckless bravery reflects his unwavering confidence in his own innocence" (John Hartley, NICOT)

Structure of defence

- 1. Character attributes (31:1-12)
- 2. Social justice credentials (31:13-28)
- 3. Obligations to the foreigner (31:29-37)
- 4. Environmental obligations (31:37-40)



Job's defence (Job 31)

Job's character attributes (31:1-12)

v.1-4 "what is our lot from God above?" v.5-6 "If I have walked in falsehood ..."

v.7-8 "If my steps have turned from the path ..."

v.9-10 "If my heart has been enticed ..."

v.11-12 "that would be wicked" } Summary

Social justice credentials (31:13-28)

v.13-15 "If I denied justice ..."
```

v.16 "If I denied the desires of the poor ..."

v.17-18 "If I kept my bread to myself ..."

v.19-20 "If I have seen anyone perishing ..."

v.21-23 "If I have raised my hand against ..."

v.24 "If I have put my trust in gold ..."

v.25 "If I have rejoiced in great wealth ..."

v.26-27 "If I have regarded the sun ..."

v.28 "These would be sins ...

Environmental obligations (31:38-40)

v.38 "If my land cries out against me ..."

v.39-40a "If I have abused my land ..."
