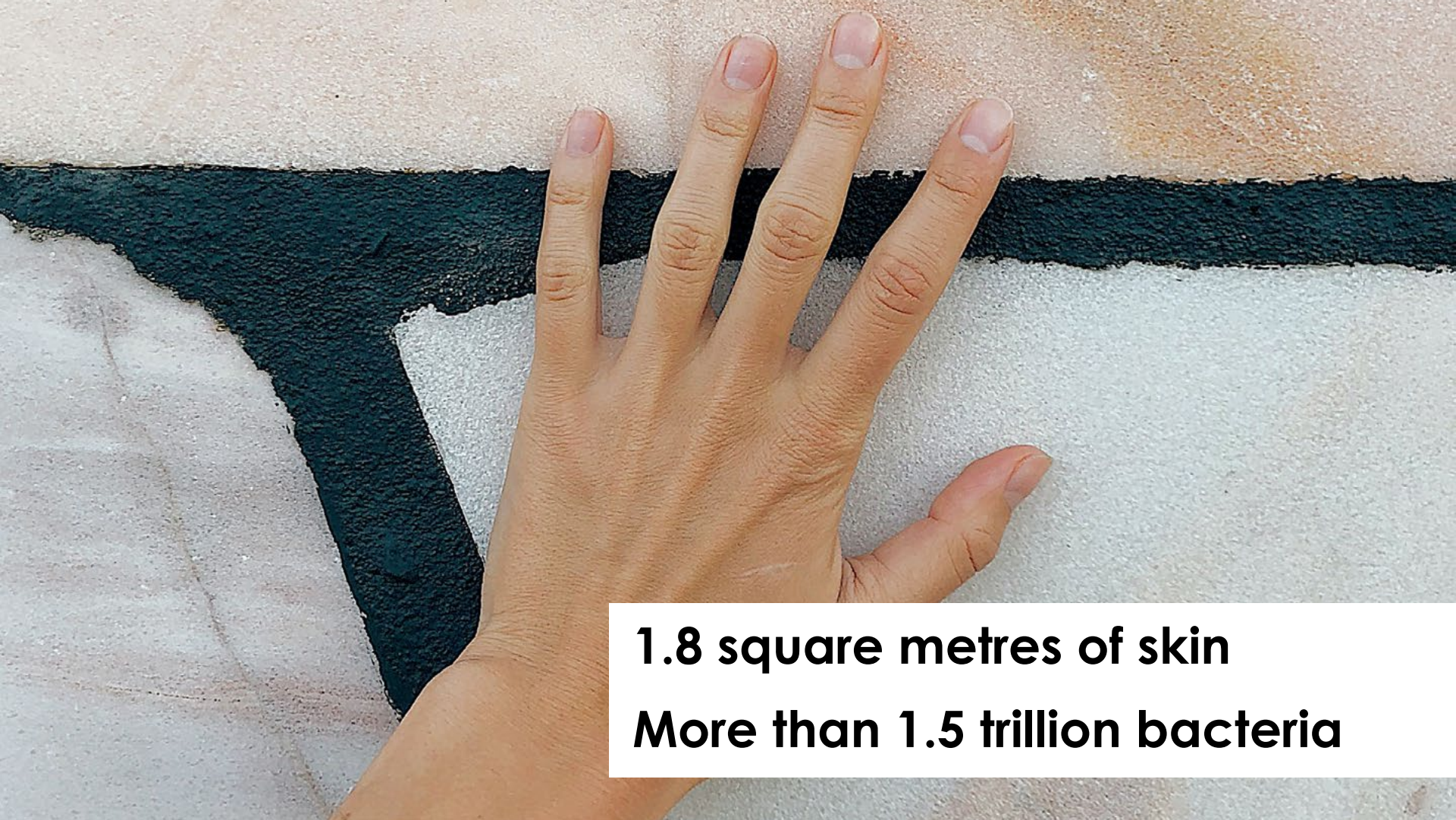

**God's focus 1: Job assuming he had wide enough perspective to judge how God runs the world**

**Job's response: I am of little importance and contemptible I will say no more 40:4-5 Amp**



## God's focus 2: Attitude behind the assumption

- “Do you presume to tell Me what I’m doing wrong?  
Are you calling Me a sinner so you can be a saint?”  
MSG
- Can you look at all who are proud and humble  
them? 40:12

Job did not suffer because he had sinned, but he did sin because he had suffered.

## **Two prayers**
