The Role – Senior Pastor

- Character and Spiritual Maturity – a godly and Spirit-filled believer with the ability to prayerfully seek God’s heart and mind for the church and its ministries with a focus on kingdom building vision.
- Pastoral Care – having a shepherd’s heart to provide and facilitate spiritual and emotional support to individuals with a focus on holistic well-being.
- Biblical Teaching and Preaching – leads the preaching and teaching ministries by communicating the Christian faith and life’s journey in an inspiring and relevant way.
- Communication – to be the primary communicator to the church family on all matters relating to the church, its vision and mission.
- Ministry Leaders’ Development – commitment to mentor and develop ministry leaders in their gifting and calling.
- Leadership – An exemplary servant leader, with the support of 12 ministry leaders and around 50 staff, the Senior Pastor will lead and coordinate the development and implementation of vision, mission and core values across the life of the church.
- Education – Suitable theological training and qualifications.
